

In this tutorial, you'll learn how to create a Table of Contents. Video, title, and image clips are the key to adding a Table of Contents (ToC) to your highlight video. By adding video clips to the Storyboard in Manager, you set reference points in the video, so that viewers can click on an entry in your ToC, and move to a specific point in your video.
